Lowering the Voting Age

An act amending Title 25 (Elections) to lower the minimum voting age from 18 to 16 years of age for all state and local elections.

Section 1. An individual who will be at least 16 years of age on the day of the next state or local election shall be eligible to register to vote, provided that the individual satisfies all other voter registration requirements.

Section 2. An individual who registers to vote and is under 18 years of age on the day of the next election shall be required to successfully complete and pass a civics education exam prior to registration.

Section 3. This act shall take effect in 30 days.
