BILL NO.	TITLE of BILL	ACTION
SENATE 1	K-12 School Day Start (Education) This bill will provide that all of Pennsylvania's elementary and secondary public schools may not begin class before 9:00 AM.	
SENATE 2	High School Sports Program Elimination (Education) A cost-saving measure to school district budgets, all high-school sports programs will be eliminated. Club sports, independent of schools, will take the place of school related sports programs.	
SENATE 3	Digital Products Sales Tax (Finance/State Government) A sales tax of 8% will be added to the sale of any digital product transferred electronically.	
SENATE 4	Drug Testing for Welfare Benefits (Finance/State Government) The Department of Human Services shall develop and implement a drug test and drug retest program for applicants and recipients of public assistance benefits.	
SENATE 5	Protecting the 2nd Amendment (Judiciary) This bill protects the rights of citizens to bear arms.	
SENATE 6	Parental Consent to Join Online Social Networks (Judiciary) This bill prohibits those under the age of eighteen (18) years of age from joining online social networks.	
SENATE 7	Rights to Social Media Upon Death (Law and Justice) This bill will give people the power to plan for the management and disposition of their digital assets in the same way they can make plans for their tangible property: by providing instructions in a will, trust, or power of attorney.	
SENATE 8	Liquor Store Privatization (Law and Justice) This bill will privatize the sale of wine and spirits in the Commonwealth to ensure that our system provides the greatest service to the citizens of Pennsylvania.	
SENATE 9	Voter Identification (Transportation) This bill will require all individuals that present themselves to vote at a Pennsylvania polling place to provide valid identification in order to cast a ballot.	
SENATE 10	Ban Cell Phones While Driving (Transportation) The use of a hand-held cellular phone while operating a motor vehicle that is in motion upon a public roadway is prohibited.
